

External Funding Assistance Programs



Mariners Volleyball Club

The Mariners Volleyball Club is a not-for-profit organization. The Club does not currently receive funding from BC Gaming.

Team or training program costs are calculated based on team expenses (tournament fees, uniforms, gym rentals, coaching expenses, equipment and administrative costs) and divided by the number of players expected per program.

In order to keep program costs as low as possible, the club operates without an overage and as such cannot fund assistance to individuals. For those athletes in financial need, please see a number of external funding programs available below.



Please note: commitment to the Mariners Volleyball Club program is ensured by the receipt of the first payment by the indicated payment due date. To be fair to all athletes, failure to pay the first instalment fee by the payment due date, forfeits acceptance and forces the club to select the next athlete.

Regrettably, external funding (such as Jumpstart, KidSport and Athletics for Kids) cannot be used for this initial payment but will be honoured for subsequent instalments.
