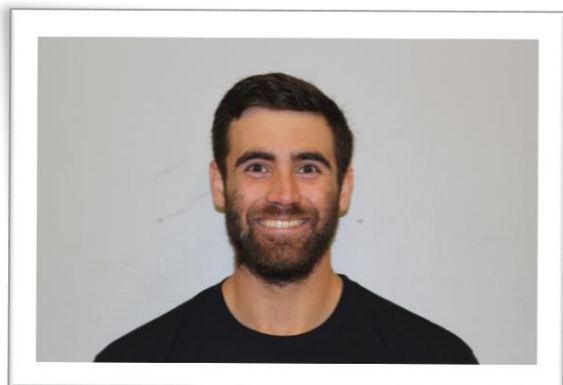


15U Boys – Craig Letourneau
