



Mariners Volleyball Club COVID-19 Confirmed Case

In the event there is a COVID-19 exposure within the Mariners Volleyball Club, the club will work in collaboration with the Island Health Authority and Volleyball BC to determine the best course of action for each individual exposure.

When an exposure is confirmed, Mariners Volleyball club will provide Island Health with the names of each of the athletes within that Mariners Volleyball cohort.

Mariners Volleyball Club will then initiate the following protocols:

- The cohort that is associated with the exposure will be contacted and informed of any training/game day cancellations pending consideration of degree of transmission risk determined by Island Health.
- Close contacts of a confirmed case will be contacted directly by Island Health and given further instructions. Only Public Health Nurses and Medical Health Officers determine who is considered a close contact.
 - Training/learning groups, friends or other connections may not be determined to be a close contact by Island Health.
 - If COVID-19 is identified in an athlete, coach or member and it is determined they were not at training/game day facility when they were infectious, members may not be contacted by Island Health because there is NO exposure to report.
- If you are not contacted by Island Health, then you are not considered a close contact and are welcome to continue to attend training sessions/game days, remembering to stay home if you feel ill or show any symptoms of illness.

- Do not attend MVC training while awaiting COVID-19 test results. Self-isolate until further direction from Island Health.
- If you have not been contacted by Island Health but feel that you may have been in close contact with a COVID-19 case, then please contact Island Health and remain at home until you receive further instruction **Phone:** 250-370-8699

- Decisions by athletes and their parents/guardians to **not** attend MVC training/games due to presentation of potential COVID-19 symptoms, will be fully supported by the club.
- In the event an entire cohort has been asked to self-isolate Mariners Volleyball Club will cancel all training sessions/games for that cohort until the isolation period has completed.
- Mariners Volleyball Club is not responsible for monitoring 14-day isolation periods for individuals. Public Health maintains daily check-ins with all individuals asked to self-isolate.



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For privacy reasons, details/names of COVID-19 exposures will **NOT** be released to members. MVC **WILL** inform members of training/game cancellations.

We ask all members (athletes, parents & coaches) to respect our MVC family member's privacy on social media platforms and in personal interactions.

MVC recognizes that resumption of sport activities may not be linear and that increasing restrictions may be required in response to fluctuating numbers of COVID-19 cases in the province or locally.

Together, through our club policies surrounding Covid-19, MVC will strive to create the safest and healthiest Return to Play for everyone.
