### AMOUNT

\$500.00 one time financial award.

### ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be members in good standing of the Mariners Volleyball Club, currently enrolled in Grade 12 studies, and will be registered at a post-secondary institution following graduation.

### APPLICATIONS

- The applicant will provide a detailed record of their athletic accomplishments in the sport of volleyball. This should include, but is not limited to...
  - Demonstrated excellence at Volleyball BC's Youth Provincial Championships and BC School Sports Championships
  - Selection to Zone 6 (Vancouver Island) representative teams (indoor and/or beach)
  - Participation in Team BC programs, training camps, selection camps and summer programming.
  - Commitment to a year of eligibility in the sport of volleyball within CCAA, U Sports or NCAA Division I or II institution.
  - Demonstrated significant potential to excel as a post-secondary student-athlete.
  - Be a positive role model for other MVC athletes.
- A reference from a past coach
  - note: can not be a member of the Mariners Volleyball Club Scholarship selection panel
- Proof of acceptance at a recognized post-secondary institution
  - note: proof of registration from a post-secondary institute is required before funds are released. Money must be claimed within two years of receiving the award. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
