1. Attendance & Commitment

- To the best of my ability, engage with my team during injury or illness by attending practices, games and meetings for learning purposes.

2. Dedication & Focus

- Give my full attention and effort during all practices, competitions and team events.
- Arrive prepared, on time and ready to contribute to my team.

3. Respect & Conduct

- Show respect to my teammates, coaches, opponents, officials, spectators and all club staff and volunteers.
- Represent Mariners Volleyball Club in a positive manner at all times, both on and off the court.

4. Health & Safety

- Report any injury or illness to my coach before participating in any training session or competition.

5. Communication

- Address concerns or complaints directly with my coach or assistant coach first, while following the ['Rule of Two'](#) guidelines.

- If further resolution is needed, raise the matter privately with the Executive Director.
- Communicate respectfully and in an appropriate setting, away from other players, parents and spectators.
